

## Packing Efficiently Checklist

Use sturdy boxes Sturdy boxes will keep their shape and allow you to stack more items on top of one another, saving you more space.
Clearly label boxes on multiple sides Labeling your box will make it easier for you to group your items together and find them when you are unpacking.
Lay a tarp, moisture absorbers & deodorizers for protection Laying a tarp or moisture absorber will help protect your items from mold and bacteria.
Defrost & empty appliances Ensure to defrost your refrigerator & freezer and drain any liquids from your dishwasher or other appliances.
Clean all appliances Cleaning your appliances ensures your items won't rust or mold over time while in storage.
Use vacuum sealed bags keep all of your bedding, draperies and clothing in vacuum sealed bags to save space.
Clean your furniture  Use a furniture polish or leather conditioner to add some additional protection to your furniture during storage.
Cover your furniture  Covering your furniture with a sheet or tarp will protect your items from dust and getting dirty.
Be creative Use up the space in your storage unit creatively, stack items, use up drawers and book shelves to maximize space.
Break down furniture When possible take apart some of your larger pieces of furniture.
Pack smart Pack items you plan on accessing during storage close to the front to make them easy to access, or create a path.
Pack alike Stack & pack similar sized boxes together to prevent boxes from breaking.
